Dear Dr. Fudin:

I am in receipt of your letter dated January 23rd, 2006, copies of which I am forwarding to the United States Attorney, the FBI, the Federal Court of Claims, and the Chairs of the House and Senate Committees on Veterans Affairs.

In light of the seriousness of the allegations, it continues to puzzle me why you resist going directly to those who have prosecutorial power.

At my request, United States Attorney Glenn Suddaby met with me in my Albany office on November 14th, 2003. You attended that meeting, along with Mr. Anthony Mariano, William Pericak of the US Attorney's office, and Charlie Diamond and Tom Matthews of my staff.

As a result of that meeting, the US Attorney commenced an investigation. To the best of my knowledge, no indictments have yet resulted from the information you and Mr. Mariano provided.

If you are withholding any relevant evidence, as your letter seems to indicate, I urge you to transmit it to Mr. Suddaby immediately.
